News from the Catholic Bishops' Conference

The Revd Dr Jan Nowotnik, a priest of the archdiocese of Birmingham and Director of Mission for the Bishops' Conference and its National Ecumenical Officer, has been appointed a non-bishop member of the 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops that will convene from 4-29 October in Rome.

Fr Nowotnik is one of 10 non-bishop members - five women, five men - representing the European continental region. They will enjoy voting rights at the Assembly, which will consist of around 370 voting members out of more than 400 total participants.

This is the first of two Synodal gatherings - the second will take place in 2024. The overall theme is *For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission*.
